“Hurts Good”

For a period of time in my high school years my Dad, brother and I got into some weight lifting and exercise. Our routine included many reps with light weight to tone muscle as well as bulk-building heavy lifting.

What I recall most is that it was hard work! It hurt! Oh, it started out alright. I'd pick up that light weight and start pumping with excitement and energy. Not only was it easy, it was fun! As

you've no doubt already concluded, that didn't last long. Soon that "light" weight became a burden and the "easy" task became painful and hard.

About the time I felt I could continue no longer someone would call out the now familiar phrase, "hurts good, hurts good." Those two simple, ironic words served as a reminder that the hurt was good because it served a purpose. My focus was taken off the pain and pointed to the desired

goal. It was a way of saying that the gain was worth the pain.

Though I have since concluded the opposite and given up weight lifting, I have often recalled those words when enduring difficult trials. When I feel overwhelmed by trials God reminds me of the desired goal.

James 1:2-4 tells us that goal— to be "perfect and complete, lacking in nothing."

When the trials overwhelm you and you are ready to give up, remember, it "Hurts Good!"

Building Committee Update: 1/7/2012

The entire elder board and building committee met at the church property at about 9:30 am on the above date to discuss the future of the rental trailer and cover structure. The building committee determined the rental would require an investment of a min. of \$4000 in carpet, paint, repairs and clean-up to re-rent the place. Since the property was purchased the net rent added over \$20,000 to the building fund. After discussion, the group decided to dispose of the trailer but keep the pole structure if possible. The building committee will carry out the disposal.

We do this to celebrate God's goodness and to vote to elect elders, deacons, deaconesses, and other officers as needed. 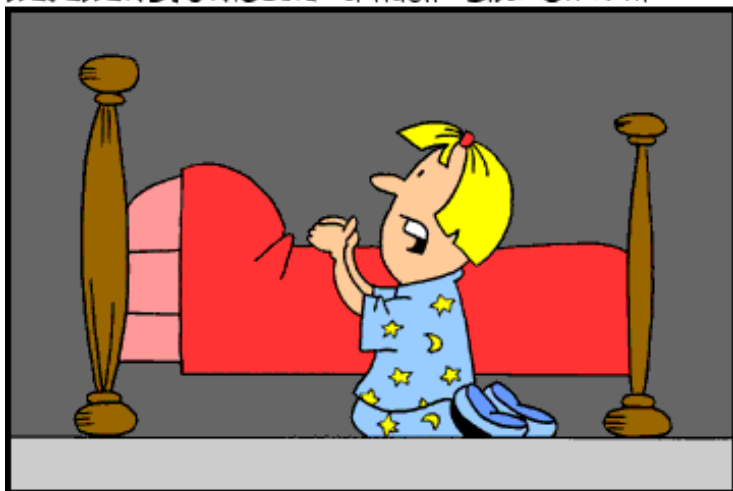

The Adult Sunday School Class has nearly completed its study from the book *The Basics*. This study will be followed up by a six week focused study on the “*Tools of the Trade*.”

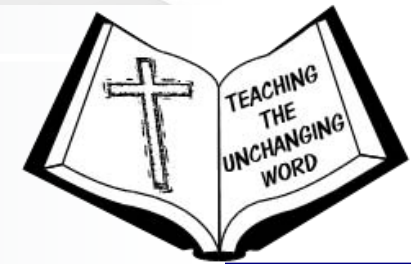
Tools of the Trade is a class designed to equip the student to dig deeper into God’s Word and gain more from your time of study. The course will include:
